Projected Feature Starting Qualifying Procedure (Subject to Change)

- o 30-car field – Qualify 26 with possible 4 Provisionals
- o Heats will be 8 laps
- o Last Chance Showdowns will be 10 laps
- o Four (4) provisional starting positions will be made available to the first four from the Final top-12 of the 2025 East Series points should any not qualify. Eligible Drivers: **Zach Buff, Kevin Chaffee, Jason Gray, DJ Robinson, Todd Buckwold, Jeremy Huntoon, Mike Wagner-Fitzgerald, Tavien Blowers, Ashton Pierson, Melvin Pierson, Mike Wright, Matt Lashua**
- o Redraw: If three Heats – Top 3 Redraw/If four or five heats – Top 2 Redraw/If six heats winner redraws. Redraw on frontstretch (*unless otherwise noted*)
- o **** Note – If we have an odd number of provisionals used, the fastest non-qualifier from qualifying could fill

DIRTcar Sportsman Series Qualifying Format (Subject to change)

- o Timed Hot laps in assigned heat groups.
- o 0-31 cars – 3 heats, 32 – 44 cars - 4 heats, 45 cars plus - 5 Heats
- o Number of cars qualify from heats and LCS will be announced at drivers meeting.
- o If you bring out a yellow during your time trial you will only be eligible for just one lap of time.

Event Specific Race Procedures

- All starts and restarts will take place in turn four at the *VP Makin' Powersign*
- The leader is the control car on all starts and/or restarts
- The leader has the choice to run inside or outside on the original start and/or all restarts
- One EZ Pass will be awarded in the feature only to the lead car one lap down.
- If scheduled EZ Pass driver brought out the yellow or pitted, no EZ is awarded
- All races will end with a green-white-checker finish
- Caution laps will not count in any race during any DIRTcar Sportsman Series qualifying events
- Feature event will be **30 laps**. Caution laps will not count.
- All restarts up to lap **30** will be double-file with lead lap cars to the front - lapped cars will drop to the inside under caution and rejoin the field beginning after the last car on the lead lap in their order of running on the race track at the time of the caution. Most restarts will be Double File. However, caution comes out before a lap is scored, the ensuing restart shall be a single file restart. Subsequent restarts revert back to double file restarts. DIRTcar and/or World Racing Group Officials reserve the right to change and/or alter this rule, provided the competitors are given notice (in advance and/or via the driver's one-way radio) due to circumstances that require such a change and/or alteration.
- If a lead lap car comes out of the pits or hot pit area while white flag (or one lap to go has been called) that car will start behind lapped cars until next yellow
- If at any time you intentionally stop on the racetrack to cause a caution and pull to the pits and change a tire that was not flat, you will be penalized one lap and will not be eligible for the EZ Pass for the rest of the event.
- World Racing Group or DIRTcar Officials reserve the right to alter the rules of this and/or any event, provided the competitors are given notice (in advance and/or over the one-way radio) due to any circumstance that require such a change or alteration
- One-way radios are mandatory. Two-way radios will not be permitted.

Technical Inspection

- Safety and General Inspection pre-race at team trailers and post-race at infield scales or designated area(s)
- Teams should be familiar with the 2026 DIRTcar Sportsman Rule Book before attending the event.

***** Note:** There will be post-race inspection in a designated inspection area or at the Series Trailer following Victory Lane Ceremonies

- Post race weight – 2400 lbs.
- **Tire Rule: LF – 300, RF – 300/400, LR – 300/400, RR – 400/500**
- **VP Fuel D98 Only**
- All cars must have **Green** verification seal.

Sonic Testing of Frame

Body Inspection

Helmet Snell FIA 8860-2018, Snell EA 2016, Snell SA 2020, Shell SA2025, and/or a valid SFI 31.1/2020 label

Fire Suit SFI 3.2 A/5 approved.

Head and Neck Restraint SFI 38.1

Drivers gloves SFI 3.3 approved.

Seat Belts SFI 16.5 or SFI 16.1 within two years from date of manufacturer

Drivers Compartment – Fuel valve and master switch must be marked on/off.

All seats must be full containment type per rule book

Fuel cells must either meet FT3 or SFI 28.3 requirements and/or Include: a metal container, foam, top bolted fuel valve plate with an operational open/close flap or roll over check valve.

Fire Suppression is mandatory – **Make sure your bottle is within certification date and in green.**

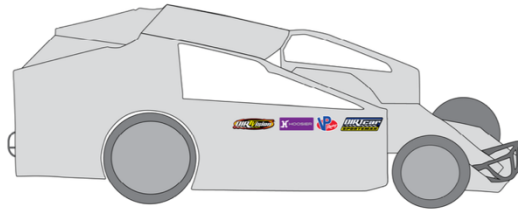
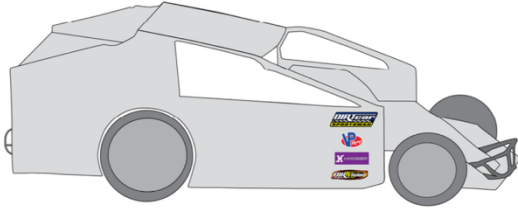
Highly recommended carburetor rollover plate

2026 Bulletin regarding DIRTcar Sportsman Series Decal Placement:

To be eligible for contingency awards — based on 2026 contingency agreements — participating manufacturer decals are mandatory. The decal must be the actual decal or proper in size and color that are included in wraps and must be placed as indicated in the accompanying photos. Mandatory decals include, but are not limited to: DIRTcar Sportsman, VP Racing Fuels, Hoosier, DIRTVision.
